

## Information Standards Notice – Change

Acting under delegated authority from the Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, the Data Alliance Partnership Board (DAPB) has approved a change to an existing information standard for publication under section 250 of the Health and Social Care Act 2012.

Standard definition	
Description	<p>The information standard provides reference data about the Organisations that comprise the health and social care services, including non-direct-care Organisations, primarily in England but also in the other UK-constituent countries. The data is distributed and uploaded to health IT systems. It supports user security, access control, messaging and is used as reference data for both operations and reporting.</p>
About this change	<p>This release formally introduces Integrated Care Boards (ICBs) into this information standard, following the publication of the Health and Care Act 2022.</p> <p>Integrated Care Boards will replace the functions of Clinical Commissioning Groups in July 2022. However, although ICB boundaries are established and known there is not enough clarity around other requirements and so the update to this standard is taking place in 2 phases; version 1.2 of this standard covers the transition phase only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Retain and rename current, active STP codes and associate new Non-Primary Role to reflect Integrated Care Boards</li> <li>• Retain and rename current, active CCG codes and associate new Non-Primary Role to reflect the Sub ICB Location / Geographical area.</li> </ul> <p>Phase 2 will be introduced at a later stage – the exact date and form of these changes is yet to be confirmed because it is dependent on the requirements of the system (discovery work is underway to establish this now), however for example it is likely to include closure of the CCG/Sub ICB Location codes and introduction of further new codes to identify ICB Place.</p>

	<p>Users should refer to the <a href="#">guidance published by NHS Digital's Organisation Data Service (ODS)</a> in relation to integrated Care Boards (ICBs).</p> <p>Note that the withdrawal of the CSV format Organisation Reference Data files, introduced in SCCI0090 Amd 24/2015, has been postponed, until the <a href="#">ODS Data Point</a>, a new tool for accessing Organisation Reference Data, reaches maturity.</p>
