

## Corrigendum

### Background

The current release of DCB0139 GUMCAD STI Surveillance System was published on 25 June 2018, with a full conformance date of 1 April 2019.

Since then the need for a minor change to the data set has been identified. A summary is provided below.

Note that there is no impact on either the published Requirements Specification or the Implementation Guidance.

However an updated Information Standards Notice has been published alongside this document, as a request for update of appropriate IT systems by 31 January 2020.

### Summary

The data set needs to be changed to add a new national code of “180 tablets” to the following attribute in the NHS Data Model and Dictionary:

#### [PRESCRIBED ITEM QUANTITIES FOR PRE EXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS](#)

Prescribing clinicians involved in the HIV PrEP Impact trial have asked for this additional code to be included so as to provide for more detailed long term surveillance. The forced use of “Other” is proving ineffective for this purpose.

The aim is to be able to identify when a patient is given a HIV PrEP prescription of 180 tablets (6 months supply) in order to effectively monitor and evaluate the NHS England funded PrEP Impact trial and the future national PrEP programme as it is currently not possible to tell whether someone with an ‘other amount’ prescription is for ‘180 tablets’ or any other amount not listed.

This issue was raised by clinicians implementing the PrEP Impact trial to the Trial Management Group (TMG) when they had to prescribe 6 months (180 tablets) worth of pills instead of 3 (90 tablets) but they could not code that in GUMCAD. This relates to section 5.4.6. of the [PrEP Impact trial protocol](#).
